A Note From YOUR VICAR

I'm back from holiday. It was good – thanks for asking :) – we went to France and drove the long way down. As our family has grown, our car has not. But living it is much harder than saying it and when we're confused in a new scenario we can revert to old favourites - well there must be something that this more expensive box is doing that the other one is not doing? 
Tots@11 for 0-3's to have a story, circle time and play with their parent/carer
